McCain's "Conservatism" — and Pratt House Pedigree

"I am a proud conservative Republican with a 17-year voting record," Senator John McCain said on NBC's Meet the Press, the day after his February 19th loss to George W. Bush in the South Carolina presidential primary. "In fact, far more conservative in many respects than Governor Bush." It's a toss-up as to what's more dubious, the Arizona's Solon's assertion, or whether being "more conservative" than George W. really says anything meaningful. After tacking hard to port for several months, the McCain campaign had collected an abundance of glowing accolades from the liberal-left Establishment media, but the South Carolina vote showed that he had alienated many conservatives and activists on the "religious right." So, now it's time to make a tactical tack to starboard.

So how conservative is McCain's voting score? According to THE NEW AMERICAN'S "Conservative Index," the Grand Canyon state's favorite son is stuck with a huge chasm between his rhetoric and his record. His Index rating has fluctuated over the years, from percentages in the low 40s to the low 80s, with his most frequent scores landing in the 50s, 60s, and 70s. Hardly the record of a conservative stalwart, and certainly not one of a constitutionalist. McCain has supported unconstitutional federal minimum wage legislation, mandatory national service, foreign aid,

Clinton's "don't ask, don't tell" homosexual policy for the military, Most Favored Nation status for Red China, subsidized "trade" with Red Vietnam, and much of the Clinton gun-control agenda. He has used his "war hero" and Vietnam POW status to provide cover for Clinton's "new world order" war-making in Bosnia and Kosovo, and to sabotage congressional investigations of live POWs left behind in Southeast Asia.

Although he's now courting the "pro-family" vote, back in November he met with leaders of the Log Cabin Republicans, the homosexual militants of the GOP, to assure them of his support for the "gay" agenda. "I am unashamed, unembarrassed and proud to work with you," McCain told GOP's sodomite cadres. McCain has a mixed record on abortion, and in the past year failed to vote on a couple of the most significant abortion bills, perhaps so as not to offend either side. Along with UN Secretary-General Boutros-Ghali, a one-world eco-socialist, Senator McCain served on the board of directors of the Caretakers of the Environment International/USA, which included among its many programs the indoctrination of American school children in the UN's green "global perspective."
